From Our Mission Director

Dear Friends of Rock Haven,

January was a busy month for several reasons. Betty and Donna were busy closing out the 2022 finances and getting the office accounting ready for 2023. The ladies would be embarrassed if I shared the number of hours that they put into the accounting and finances for RHM, so let me just say it is a lot. They work diligently to make sure that the finances are clear and transparent to anyone who may have a question. Bob and Kermit had to designate a lot of their time for isolating and fixing leaks on the camp property. Both Bob and Kermit worked hard to get those leaks taken care of so we could focus on the other things that need to be accomplished before camp season begins. I am very grateful that we have been good stewards of the

money that is provided for the camp ministry. We were able to pay the increase in the water bill and the cost of repairs, although we had to use funds that we would have used for this summer's camp program. We are trusting God to replace those funds so we can have an exciting summer of ministry with the children and youth that will be at camp this summer.

Kermit has picked out the theme for this year's camp ministry: "Outrageous Truth." The Bible verse is John 8:32, "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Kermit and the staff have been working diligently as they consider how to decorate and program this year's camp weeks. We already have commitments from men who are going to come and share the Gospel with the kids this summer and challenge them to live their lives in a way that honors God. Kermit and the team will have the Bible lessons completed in a few more weeks and will be able to turn their attention to

some of the other program aspects of the camp ministry. Please, pray for Kermit and the staff as they seek to bring glory to God through everything that is done in the camp ministry.

From Our Church Relations, Evangelism, and Outreach Director

Dear Friends,

First of all, it is great to be back serving with Rock Haven Ministries. For those who may not know me, I served as Camp Director from the Fall of 1998 to the Spring of 2015.

In between then and the present, the Lord called me to serve with Child Evangelism Fellowship. I was the Local Director for Northwest Arkansas. I received training to be more effective in reaching young children for the Gospel.

While serving with Rock Haven earlier, I came to know of Marie Olsen. She was the founder of North Arkansas Gospel Mission. She was also trained with CEF and brought her knowledge and burden for the lost to our area. Eventually others followed her and the Bible ladies were able to go into the public schools to evangelize the boys and girls directly. The need for a Bible Camp soon followed. I was honored to serve here and know the Bible ladies.

In October of 2022, the Lord called me back to serve with RHM. My role is Director of Church Relations and Evangelism/Outreach. Church Relations means exactly that. RHM exists to aid the local churches by building a strong relationship and coming alongside them to help them reach the lost in their community. This assistance could take different forms, depending on need. It could mean having me come and provide pulpit supply for a Sunday. It could mean having me come and share ministry training to be more effective in reaching the boys and girls in their community.

One service of the Evangelism/Outreach role is to assist churches in conducting either a weeklong or one day Vacation Bible School. Our vision is to put together 'Rock Haven in a Box', a trailer equipped with fun activities that could be used to travel to churches and present the Gospel to the area children. All of this is

coming alongside the local church and their members to help them grow.

Another area of evangelism/outreach is to start and/or help maintain Bible Clubs in our public schools. The Bible Ladies were faithful in the work and I hope to see it continue. I am currently in contact with an area church that want us to provide training for their volunteers to restart a club that was discontinued because of COVID. Thankfully, other school clubs are beginning back after COVID. I will be assisting this church by teaching the Bible Lesson portion of the club.

As I stated in the beginning, it is great to be back serving at Rock Haven Ministries. If I can in any way

serve your church please don't hesitate to contact us. To God be the glory for all He will do and has already done.

Project Updates

It is such a joy to share with you that, little by little, we have seen people catch



the vision of seeing the Tim Bartlow Recreation Center completed. In November, I made you aware that we had \$27,000 in the Recreation Center fund. Today, I am happy to tell you we are up to \$35,200. We have seen an increase of \$8,200 in 3 months. Praise the Lord!

I am also excited to share with you that Kurt Goodall has volunteered his time and skills to be the project manager of the Recreation Center. In early January Kurt visited with Kermit, Bob, and myself, sharing with us his financial support. vision for how he wants to see this project completed to the glory of God and to further God's Kingdom through our efforts at Rock Haven. In our time together, we prayed, we walked the property where the recreation center will be built, and we visioned just how needed the recreation center is to the camp ministry. Rock Haven had an impact on Kurt's life at a young age and now he is allowing God to use him be a part of a project that is going to impact the lives of many youth for years to come. I am very excited that we have someone with Kurt's skillset and character managing such a big project. As I prayed about the prayer support and financial support to become available for the Recreation Center, I was also praying for someone skilled in this area to manage this project. Repeatedly I am reminded that this is the biggest project that the ministry has ever undertaken. Repeatedly I am reminded that we have a great big God and I believe our big God answered another prayer by prompting Kurt to reach out and see how he could partner with Rock Haven see the recreation center completed.

Every stage of the recreation center will begin as the

money becomes available. We are still \$50,000 away from getting the dirt work and slab completed. I have been asked "do you get discouraged that it is taking so long for the funds to be available?" The answer is always no. I am trusting and waiting on God to provide for this project in His time and through His people. Am I excited and wished it was already completed? Yes! Because I know how much of an impact it will have on the lives of so many people.
